ABSTRACT

Novita Jakaria, 2022. Analysis of the Contribution of the Agricultural Sector to Regional Original Income (PAD). (Case study: West Halmahera Regency 2017-2021 Period), under the guidance of Bakri Soamole, S.E., M.Si as Supervisor I and Mohammad Khotib, S.E., M.Si as Supervisor II.

This study aims to: (1). To find out the contribution of the agricultural sector to the Regional Original Income (PAD) of West Halmahera Regency for the 2017-2021 period. (2). To find out the relationship between local revenue (PAD) and the agricultural sector of West Halmahera Regency for the 2017-2021 period. (3). To find out the efforts made by the government to increase the contribution of the agricultural sector to the local revenue (PAD) of West Halmahera Regency for the 2017-2021 period. Analyzing the level of contribution of the agricultural sector to the Regional Original Income (PAD) of West Halmahera Regency during a certain period. The data used is time series data for 2017-2021. While the analysis model used is contribution analysis.

The results showed that the agricultural sector contributed significantly to the PAD of West Halmahera Regency. In total, Regional Original Income contributed from the agricultural sector during 2017-2021 has an average of 6,640,000.00 million per year or 0.0214% per year. In theory, the relationship between the agricultural sector and PAD is a functional relationship, because the agricultural sector is a function of Regional Original Income (PAD). Where the increasing retribution for the agricultural sector will increase local government revenues to finance development programs consisting of taxes and regional levies. So recently the government of West Halmahera Regency has tried to make PERDA for fruits, for example (durian, langsa, rambutan) and other fruits so that the results of these fruits are for the development of the agricultural sector so that in the future or the following year the results of these fruits can be included in local revenue. In this case, the government will add regional regulations on agriculture (fruits) aimed at increasing regional income from the agricultural sector so that it is more advanced and developed.
