In writing, there are a number of language aspects involved such as model texts, prepositions, spell-check, punctuation and grammar.

Brown (1994 : 205) states that an errors is a deviation from the adult grammar of a native speaker. Finding L2 learners' errors is an evidence of a

process of learning because an error has played an important role in study of language acquisition

In English learning process, EFL students are difficult to avoid making an error. It can be caused by two main factors. The first factor is influenced by their mother tongue or first language.

Analysis of error made by the learner is one of the ways to show the true proficiency level of target language they are learning at a particular time.

Writing is one of English language skills to express or to transfer thoughts and feelings. Writing is a form of communication to deliver thought or to express feeling through written form.
