CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Research

English is an international language that is spoken and studied by people from all over the world. According to Keller in (Dhamayanti, 2021) Motivation is a Psychological phenomenon in the form of encouragement to act with a specific purpose.
