CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

The use of podcasts in various fields is growing, including one in the field of education, so that the use of podcasts in learning is expected to attract students' attention to learning, especially listening learning. Podcasting is regarded as one of the unique forms of audio and video materials that provide language learners with numerous possibilities to improve their language skills. Thus, students' listening skills can be utilized as much as possible.

at any time and from any location. Podcasts can help students practice their pronunciation.

To reflect or consider the listening problems and previous studies above, the researcher is determined to test the use of podcasts on students' listening skills. Based on the above background, the researcher is interested in conducting research on students' listening skills through English learning podcasts in the fifth semester of English Department students at Khairun University. The purpose of this study to determine the effect of using English podcasts in improving students' listening skills.
