CHAPTER 1

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background

The language in literary works has its own uniqueness because it uses a language style where every word has a beautiful meaning in the literary work. The role of meaning in literary works is very influential, every reader who wants to understand literary works must understand the science of meaning as a provision for understanding literary works. This is what makes semantics very important in literary studies, especially those related to the study of meaning in language style

According to Nurgiyantoro (2013: 271) in a literary work, language style plays a role in beautifying, enlivening, warming, concretizing, mocking, condensing and optimizing the literary work. This is because literary language is written to gain the power of expression so that language is circumvented, manipulated and used as precisely as possible so that literary language is different from non-literary language.

The creation of a literary work itself will never be separated from the use of language style, because language style has a useful function in the process of creating a literary work. One of them is because language style is part of diction, namely about the choice of words which questions whether or not the use of certain words, phrases or clauses is suitable to express certain situations (Kerafl, 2009: 136). One of the things included in language style is the technique of figure of speech. This technique of expression is a technique of expressing language whose meaning does not show or show the literal meaning of the words that support it, but rather the implied meaning.

There are many types of figures of speech according to experts, but the most frequently mentioned are four types, namely: comparative figure of speech, satire figure of speech, relationship figure of speech, and conflict figure of speech.

According to Abrams (1981:63), figurative language is a deviation from the use of language by speakers from the understanding of everyday language (ordinary), a deviation from standard language, or a deviation from the meaning of words, a deviation from a series of words in order to obtain some special meaning.

Metaphor is a choice of diction that is not the real meaning. The meaning conveyed is not instantaneous and uses beautiful word choices. So that it creates something certain that the author wants. Metaphorical expressions in literary works are determined by the similarities or comparisons of the diction used to describe actual reality with the results of abstract thoughts that want to be depicted. Metaphors do not only act as similarities or comparisons of diction, but metaphors are based on the poet's experiences and observations of the surrounding environment, so that imagination appears as expressed in literary works.

Songs are literary works that can be researched scientifically. Songs are a type of literary work which essentially tells or depicts events briefly and is covered with tones that cover human life such as sadness, joy, love and suffering. Songs are a medium used to provide information or convey messages. The form of writing song lyrics is almost the same as writing poetry which consists of lines and stanzas. Thus, song lyrics can be analyzed like a text. In conveying his feelings, the songwriter chooses words that have appeal so that they will create imagination in the lyrics conveyed with musical

accompaniment. Metaphors in songs are expressions of the songwriter's feelings about something that touches the heart and is experienced in the reality of the songwriter's life, expressed in written form using beautiful language. Relating to how songwriters express ideas, thoughts or feelings through their works.

Song lyrics have two meanings, explained in Moeliong (2007: 628). as follows, song lyrics as literary works in the form of poetry contain outpouring of the heart, as a composition of a song. To use a lyric a poet must be clever in processing words. The word song has meaning various kinds of rhythmic sounds (2007:624). The song lyrics are the result of a combination of language arts and sound arts, as an involving sound art work singer's voice color and melody

Coldplay's songs are one of the songs that have a very deep understanding of a person's life, while this song contains great motivation so that everyone can be themselves, not like other people, if studied further this song really has a different concept. very good. broad but also interesting to listen to, a song that teaches you to be free to express whatever you want.

of the many coldplay songs, researcher will focus on 10 songs, namely, titles including Up&Up, Army of the One, Speed Of Sound, A Sky full of Stars, Adventure of a Lifetime, Higher Power, Viva La Vida, Birds, everglow, A Head Full of Dreams

From the definition above, researcher will conduct research that focuses on the types of metaphors and metaphorical meanings contained in the lyrics of By Coldplay's songs which indirectly contain many of the language styles used by the author. So researchers only focus on metaphorical language styles and so on.
