CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the research

English is a foreign language (EFL) in Indonesian English as a pronunciation model and as a standard for understanding various messages in various contexts, both academic and social. In teaching listening skill Brown (2000:7) states that teaching is showing or helping someone to learn how to do something, giving instructions, guiding in the study of something, providing with knowledge, causing to know or understand. Listening has also been considered from a further perspective in recent years when it is examined in relation not only to comprehension, but also to language learning. In relation to student listening comprehension, the students still face difficulty in listening accurately referring to the result of the researcher's interview with the English teacher in SMP N 39 Halmahera Barat, most of the students got bad so one in listening skill it is caused by their lack of vocabulary so they can't understand what has been listened from the audio.

Based on the problems above the teacher should find solution to overcome the students' problem. Teaching listening requires a bit more on the part of the teacher than that of the learners. One of the main principle of teaching listening, should be "Language material intended to used for training listening comprehension should never be presented visually first." Good listening lessons go beyond the main listening task itself with related activities before and after the listening. It means that the teaching oflistening should beyond the understanding, then the action.
