English is the language most often learned by non-native speakers around the world in two ways: one is learning English as a second language (ESL) in English speaking countries, for example, New Zealand; and the other is learning English as a foreign language (EFL) in many countries around the world, especially in Asian countries, for example, in China. It is estimated that non native English speakers now outnumber native speakers by a ratio of 3

to 1 (Crystal, 2003:69) in Wang X (2009:20). Therefore, English language education in ESL and EFL contexts has become a significant world-wide industry, and research on English language teaching and learning has played an important role in the development of English language education. Even though there are many researchers focused on English language education, there are relatively few studies which have compared EFL and ESL practice.

English as a communication tool is used to convey ideas, thoughts, opinions, feelings, and also to respond to or create discoursein community life. To be able to learn English withwell needed knowledge will be characteristic of the English language itself. Each subject has certain characteristics when viewed in terms of objectives or competencies to be achieved, or material learned in ordersupport these competencies. In terms of objectives or competencies to be achieved, these English subjects emphasize aspectslanguage skills that include oral and written language skills, bothreceptive and productive. These characteristics distinguish between one eyelessons with other subjects.
