

ABSTRACT

Sarah's Key is a novel by the author Tatiana de Rosnay telling a story about two main characters at two different times, namely the past and the present. This novel tells the story of the conditions in France during a big roundup of holocaust on July 1942 of the era of the second world war and about the life of the French people in 2002. The holocaust that occurred about 60 years ago still had a serious impact on its victims.

This study aims to discuss the inhumanity side which reflected in the novel Sarah's Key through the Social Psychology Approach. First, analyzing the actions which included in the inhumanity acts. Second, it discusses the factors that cause the inhumanity acts. Third, it discusses the impacts resulting from these inhumanity acts, both physical, mental and social impacts.

This research uses the descriptive analysis method to study the problems in the form of narration and analysis. First, the researcher read the Sarah's Key novel repeatedly to comprehend every content related to the topic of the problem. Second, the researcher sorts out the contents which are also related to the topic of the problem. Third, the researcher analyzes each novel's contents, such as the dialogue and the character's expressions that lead to the topic of the problem. Fourth, the researcher explains each data which obtained and provide more detailed explanation and draw the conclusions from the research results which obtained. The researcher also read other references which relate to the title of the study to facilitate the analysis to be done.

From the research in the novel, it can be concluded that there are three actions that are included in the inhumanity acts committed against the French Jews, namely the arrest, massacres which is part of genocide, and the persecution carried out by the French Police on the authorization of Nazi Germany in 1942 during the time of the second world war. The various inhumanity acts which found in this novel were caused by the Nazi's orders and the anti-Semitism. These actions had a serious impact on the lives of the Jews, they suffered so much during the big roundup carried out by the French Police.
