Penelitian ini dilakukan dengan tujuan untuk mengetahui persepsi masyarakat nelayan di Kota Ternate dalam menghadapi dampak perubahan iklim pada Kelurahan Makassar Timur Kecamatan Ternate Tengah Kota Ternate. Metode penelitian yang digunakan adalah penelitian kualitatif. Teknik penelitian yang dilakukan dengan cara wawancara dan telah di dokumentasi. Partisipan yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah perwakilan 10 orang masyarakat nelayan aktif yang dipilih secara acak di Kelurahan Makassar Timur.

Berdasarkan hasil penelitian nelayan Kelurahan Makassar Timur sudah mengetahui bentuk perubahan iklim yang terjadi. Hal tersebut didasari pengalaman nelayan selama hidup dipesisir Kelurahan Makassar Timur yang dari tahun ke tahun selalu terjadinya tanda-tanda dari perubahan. Terjadinya perubahan iklim juga tidak bisa ditebak. Namun mampu dirasakan oleh nelayan seperti sumberdaya perikanan yang semakin berkurang, pendapatan nelayan berkurang, tidak jelasnya musim dan cuaca ekstrim. Selain dampak ekonomi, perubahan iklim juga berdampak langsung pada lingkungan yaitu naiknya permukaan air laut.

ABSTRACT

This research was conducted with the aim of knowing the perception of the fishing community in Ternate City in dealing with the impacts of climate change in East Makassar Village, Central Ternate District, Ternate City. The research method used is qualitative research. The research technique was carried out by means of interviews and has been documented. The participants used in this study were representatives of 10 fishing communities who were randomly selected in the East Makassar Village

Based on the results of research, fishermen in East Makassar Village already know the form of climate change that is occurring. This is based on the experience of fishermen during their life on the coast of East Makassar Village, which from year to year always shows signs of change. The occurrence of climate change is also unpredictable. However, it can be felt by fishermen such as diminishing fishery resources, reduced fishermen's income, unclear seasons and extreme weather. In addition to the economic impact, climate change also has a direct impact on the environment, namely rising sea levels.
