#### **CHAPTER I**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Therefore, before creating a lyric, the author needs to understand the language features that should be used or implemented. In a lyric, often the linguistic features used are figurative languages, so the meaning of the lyrics cannot be understood literally. Where, the listeners need to interpret the connotative words in it. There are five figurative languages that are often found or used in songs namely, metaphore, simile, personification, hyperbole, alliteration.

Figurative language is basically used by literature to acquire and create imagery. The presence of figurative speech causes the work literature attracts attention, gives rise to clarity of wishful thinking. Waluyo (1991) stated that figurative language is a language which poets use to say things in an unusual way did not directly reveal the meaning. Therefore, it is important people to know the meaning of the figurative language found in a song lyric, so they can imagine what happens in the story, and they can feel and play with the emotion in the story in the

song lyrics. Darmayasa (2015), explained about figurative language that give more meaning to the words, beautify them, and emphasize their meaning. In addition, figurative languages provide so many variants style of saying something in different styles.

One types of figurative language is personification. Knickerbocker and Reninger (1963) stated that personification is one figures of speech which giving human characteristic to non-human things. It is implied comparison between human being and non-human things. Personification is important in the song lyrics in order to focus on giving the listeners a thought of weirdness that allows listeners to develop a greater sense of identification with nonhuman entities which described as if they have human abilities and attributes as well as it can make the thing easier to understand and more vivid in the listeners' imagination.

Michael Joseph Jackson is an American singer and songwriter. He is known as the "King of Pop" and has popularized the "Moonwalk" dance movement that has become a characteristic of him. Michael Jackson's main genres were pop, rock, R&B and soul. He was also known for his influence in the music video and dance industries. Some of Michael Jackson's songs are about the reflection of life that exists in society and there's probably a lot of personification in it so that Michael Jackson's lyrics were chosen as a data source for analysis because the lyrics are interesting to read and analyzed because they contain many personified sentences.

One of the examples of personification in the Michael Jackson'song "Heal the world, Personification" is "Let our spirits never die". Michael Jackson uses

personification in these lyrics because he wants to convey to people that his spirit will never die as healing for the world.
