ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui hambatan berbicara mahasiswa dan cara mengatasinya pada semester empat program studi Bahasa Inggris. Satu dosen dan dua puluh mahasiswa semester empat diambil sebagai subjek penelitian. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif untuk mengumpulkan dan menganalisis data. Penelitian ini dilakukan dengan memberikan observasi dan wawancara sebagai instrumennya. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan terdapat beberapa kendala yang dihadapi mahasiswa yang terbagi menjadi dua faktor yaitu faktor internal dan faktor eksternal. Dilihat dari faktor internal, terdapat tujuh kendala yang dihadapi mahasiswa dalam belajar berbicara, seperti kurangnya kosakata, tata bahasa yang buruk, kecemasan berbicara, takut melakukan kesalahan, rendahnya partisipasi, rendahnya rasa percaya diri, dan penggunaan bahasa ibu. Faktor eksternal terbagi menjadi dua yaitu lingkungan dan kepribadian dosen. ABSTRACT

Novirjayanty Muhajir.(2024). Students' Speaking Obstacles In The Fourth Semester Of The English Language Education Study Program. The first supervisor is Drs. Taib Latif, M.Hum and the second supervisor is Indry Widyasti Anwar, S.Pd., M.A.

This study aims to determine students' speaking obstacles and how they overcome them in the fourth semester of the English language study program. One lecturer and twenty students in the fourth semester were taken as research subjects. This study uses a descriptive qualitative method for collecting and analyzing data. This research is conducted by providing observations and interviews as an instrument. The results of the study show that there are several obstacles faced by students that are divided into two factors, namely internal factors and external factors. In terms of internal factors, there are seven obstacles faced by students in learning to speak, such as lack of vocabulary, poor grammar, speaking anxiety, fear of making mistakes, low participation, low self-confidence, and mother tongue use. External factors are divided into two categories: environment and lecturer's personality. Students enhance their speaking skills through various methods, including joining an English club or course, forming groups for practice or discussion, learning on social media, listening to English songs and podcasts, and watching movies.
