The purpose of this research is to describe the way the hegemony of the ruling class, the ideology of the characters and the role of intellectuals. The role of Intellectuals. there are Organic intellectuals, illustrated by the figure of Tan Malaka. who founded an organization for fellow Indies students while studying in the Netherlands, as well as building folk schools and gathering all groups from various circles and ideologies.
