CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of the Research

From the results of observations found when researcher carried out the Merdeka Belajar Kampus Merdeka (MBKM) program precisely at SMA Negeri 19 South Halmahera. There are problems that have been found when carrying out activities, so the study chose a school to be the object in the problem.

This is due to most students still having difficulty in writing. Students do not understand how to develop their ideas so that the benefits and enjoyment of writing are reduced, as for other factors that affect students' ability to write, namely (1) determining unattractive titles, (2) difficulty in developing storylines, and (3) developing ideas.

Another aspect related to low writing is the lack of motivation and enthusiasm of students in learning to write variously. In addition, students find it difficult to determine the idea of the topic and do not know how to start writing, and students cannot develop ideas.

By using a problem-based learning model in writing explanatory texts, it is hoped that it can help students in developing good writing skills and being able to think in this case is a problem-solving skill. Students can build and analyze authentic problems.

The problem-based learning model is a way of teaching where students carry out practical activities so that students have higher skills than what has been learned.

Problem Based Learning models that are used as an effort to solve problems in writing explanatory texts and n will create conditions for more active students.
