

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan menganalisis pengaruh tenaga kerja, investasi, inflasi, dan Covid-19 terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi di Indonesia periode 2010-2023, berikut juga menganalisis tingkat kepekaan pertumbuhan ekonomi di Indonesia sebagai akibat perubahan yang terjadi pada kesempatan kerja, investasi, tingkat inflasi, dan Covid-19 selama periode yang sama. Penelitian ini menggunakan alat uji yakni analisis regresi linier berganda dengan menggunakan *Statistical Package for Social Scientist* (SPSS) sebagai alat bantu.

Berdasarkan hasil analisis data dengan menggunakan model regresi logaritma ganda (*double logaritm*), diperoleh hasil uji-F dan uji-t yang memberikan kesimpulan bahwa variabel-variabel bebas tenaga kerja, investasi, tingkat inflasi, dan covid-19 secara individu (parsial) maupun serentak (kolektif) berpengaruh signifikan terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi di Indonesia. Meskipun demikian, tingkat kepekaan perubahan dari semua variabel bebas tersebut bersifat tidak elastis terhadap pertumbuhan ekonomi di Indonesia

ABSTRAC

This research aims to analyze the influence of labor, investment, inflation, and Covid-19 on economic growth in Indonesia for the 2010-2023 period, as well as analyzing the level of sensitivity of economic growth in Indonesia as a result of changes that occur in employment opportunities, investment, inflation rates, and Covid-19 during the same period. This research uses a test tool, namely multiple linear regression analysis using the Statistical Package for Social Scientists (SPSS) as a tool.

Based on the results of data analysis using a double logarithm regression model, the results of the F-test and t-test were obtained which concluded that the independent variables were labor, investment, inflation rate and Covid-19 individually (partially) and simultaneously (collectively) have a significant effect on economic growth in Indonesia. However, the level of sensitivity to changes in all of these independent variables is inelastic to economic growth in Indonesia.
